





Zoom rules:

- Ensure you are on a stable and sufficiently fast internet connection (Wifi or ethernet). If your WiFi is spotty or prone to fluctuations use an ethernet connection instead.
- If the connection is bad or there is interference: Switch off video transmission. Speakers, however, should always be on video.
- Use clear names: Please make sure that your first name and last name are visible in the virtual space.
- Preferably use a headset (if available). If not available make sure you are in a quiet room without disturbance and background noise.
- When you're not talking, turn off the microphone. The host of the meeting can also mute participants, so please don't misunderstand this as rude behavior. If you are muted, indicate that you want to talk by raising your hand.
- Announce own contributions by hand sign or in the chat, maybe wait for the word.
- Use chat: There is a chat in Zoom that you can use to ask questions, make comments, or share useful information.
- Use visual feedback: use the options to give visual feedback by using the icons in the control.

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

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

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
